

If « Les Darons » is based on Grenache planted on AOP soil, « Le Fiston » is based on Cinsault on IGP ground. This new IGP appellation incorporates all the counties of of Aude, Hérault and Gard.





Appellation: IGP Terres du Midi

Vintage: 2021 Alcohol: 13.5%

Grape varieties: Grenache / Cinsault / Carignan

Terroir: Silicious-clay and old alluvial deposits.

Vinification methods: Destemmed and crushed underfoot, without sulphites / Pruned in Goblet and conventional Guyot form.

Maturing: In tanks.

Tasting notes:

More floral, fresher and less powerful than Les Darons, it is as authentic an expression of the wines from the Midi as Les Darons are.

Pairing:

Great for aperitifs, with a quick snack and ideal with barbecue...

Recommendations:

Serve between 12 and 14°C Aging potential: At least 8 years.
