Grenache Under My Skin



There are 2 areas in the Mediterranean renowned for Grenache; Châteauneuf and Maury



Appellation: AOP Maury Sec

Vintage: 2023

Alcohol: 14.5%

Grape varieties: 80% Grenache / 20% Syrah

Terroir: Schist of Maury.

Vines: 60+ year old Grenache pruned in Goblet form / 15+ year old Syrah in Cordon de Royat form / Yield of 24 hl/ha.

Vinification methods: Manual harvesting / Grapes are destemmed and crushed / Long maceration / Only juices of Grenache and Syrah are assembled together.

Maturing: In tanks with fine lees during winter without SO2.

Tasting notes:

The colour is an intense violet with garnet highlights.

The nose is seductive, with morello cherry and spicy aromas.

Slender and full on the palate, it develops notes of black and red fruit, blackcurrant and cocoa, with a hint of spice and liquorice.

The tannins are silky, and the long finish is chocolaty and spicy. A wine that proves that concentration can go hand in hand with great finesse.

Pairing:

Grilled red meat dishes, game, lamb, sheep's tomme...

Recommendations:

Serve at 15°C

Aging potential: At least 10 years.
