Appellation: AOP Fitou

Vintage: 2021

Alcohol: 14.5%

Grape varieties: 60% Carignan / 40% Syrah

Terroir: 50+ year old Carignan pruned in Goblet form, and 30+ year old Syrah in Guyot form both on the schist of Villeneuve les Corbières.

Vines: In the process of conversion to organic culture.

Vinification methods: Manuel harvest / Syrah are destemmed and crushed / Fermentation well underway the more mature Carignan are added (whole harvest) for carbonic maceration (CM) / CM finished, the wine is racked and juices and pressed matter are assembled.

Maturing: In tanks

Tasting notes:

Cardinal red.

Aromas of red fruits and spices.

Intense notes of blueberries, blackberries, pepper, liquid violets and scrubland, with delicate tannins and a nice crisp acidity. Plenty of freshness and tension.

Pairing:

Serve at 16°C
