Appellation: AOP Maury

Vintage: 2016

Alcohol: 14%

Grape varieties: 60% Grenache / 40% Mourvèdre

Terroir: On the schist of Maury / 50+ year old Grenache / 10 year old Mourvèdre / On the central area of the Maury appellation, towards the south for the Grenache and further north for the Mourvèdre.

Vinification methods: Manual harvesting, the grape varieties are vinified separately, destemmed, crushed, with a small percentage of whole harvest. Maceration of fruits and juices during fermentation, the grapes are then extracted from the tanks and pressed, juices and pressed matters are assembled. The blend is finalised in June for bottling in September.

Maturing: In tanks.

Tasting notes:

Barely translucent, a deep dark purple.

The nose is full of dark fruits (cherries, blackberry cream), but also a pinch of cocoa.

Round and ample on the palate, with a dense and velvety matter, and the tension of the schist. The finish is firm with ripe tannins. The cherry is ever-present before moving on to pepper and cocoa at the end.

Pairing:

Mixed grills; red meat and poultry...

Recommednations:

Serve at 14°C

Aging potential: 5 to 6 years
