Appellation: IGP Pays d'Oc

Vintage: 2021

Alcohol: 13%

Grape varieties: 100% Sauvignon

Terroir: Clay and limestone / Black marl on calcified plaque without chlorosis.

Vines: Pruned at the spine.

Vinification methods: Mechanically performed grape harvest / Pellicular maceration / Fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

Maturing: Tel que fin de fermentation / Sur lies / Sans batonnage.

Tasting notes:

Pale gold.

On notes of white fruits and citrus.

A dry white, easy to drink, aromatic and greedy, full of freshness and with a lovely acidity. The Sauvignon gives a dry wine, very perfumed, balanced with very different aromas; floral, berries, fruit or minerals.
