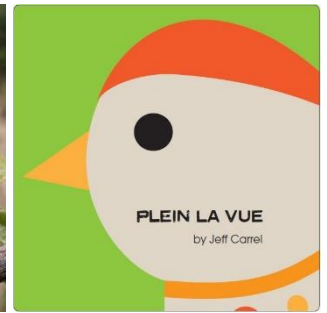


Jeff Carrel Plein la Vue

Appellation: VDF

Vintage: 2021

Alcohol: 12.5%

Grape varieties: Sauvignon Blanc

Terroir: Siliceous clay / Mediterranean climate, northern exposure.

Vines: Organic culture, conversion to biodynamic.

Vinification methods: Directly pressed / Maceration on must deposit / Cold settling / Vinification and aging without sulphites on cold lees.

Maturing: Without sulphites when cold on lees.

Tasting notes:

Nose of white fruit and citrus.

Fresh, long and palatable fruit.

Pairing: Friends for aperitif and shellfish...

Recommendations:

Serve cold, between 8 and 10°C

Aging potential: Springs to mind a 1999 Puydeval Sauvignon that was still doing well 15 years later.
