Appellation: AOP Beaujolais Villages

Vintage: 2019

Alcohol: 13.5%

Grape varieties: 100% Gamay

Terroir: Granitic ground.

Vines: Pruned in Goblet form.

Vinification methods: Carbonic maceration / Vinified without sulphites / Natural yeasts.

Maturing: Without sulphites / On fine lees.

Tasting notes:

A pale translucent red of a maple leaf in the light of an autumn morning.

A panier of peppery red fruit is a welcome aroma on the nose whilst also developing floral notes.

A delicate taste until the end which urgently creates the need to take another sip.

Pairing:

Cold meat platters for aperitifs, simmered or grilled meats, the list goes on and on...

Recommendations:

Serve between 12 and 13°C

Aging potential: Drink whilst the fruit is still fresh, but will easily keep for 3 to 5 years
