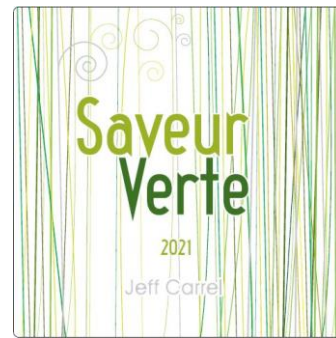


# Jeff Carrel Saveur Verte

**Appellation:** IGP Côtes Catalanes

**Vintage:** 2021

**Alcohol:** 13.5%

**Grape varieties:** 92% Muscat d'Alexandrie / 8% Muscat petits grains

**Terroir:** Clay and limestone.

**Vines:** Pruned in Goblet and Royat forms.

**Vinification methods:** The grapes are harvested at optimum ripeness / Pressed very softly / winemaking at controlled temperatures.

**Maturing:** On lees.

**Tasting notes:**

Golden reflections.

Aromas of the Traminer variety, exotic fruits (lychee), walnut, hazelnut as well as vegetal and mineral aromas.

With 7 grams of residual sugar, a touch of acidity and its discrete bubbly effect, can be perceived floral notes (rose), orange zest and mature peaches. The end taste is fairly full bodied and structured but leaves a beautiful freshness on the palate.

Serve between 8 and 10°C
