

Jeff Carrel Super Mule Rouge



« If the *Vieille Mule* isn't enough for you, and if the end of your evening is missing a bit of swing, *Super Mule* to the rescue! »

Appellation: IGP Côtes Catalanes
Vintage: 2021
Alcohol: 16%
Grape varieties: 100% Super Grenache

Terroir: On black marl, called « les Pierres Noires » (black stones) between Maury and Estagel / From a selection of vines over 60 years old.

Vines: Density of plantation between 3300 and 4000 roots per ha / Pruned dependant on the vintage / Low yield of approximately 27hl/ha.

Vinification methods: Destemmed and crushed / Cold pre-fermentation maceration / Alcoholic fermentation / Extraction using pumping-over technic.

Maturing: In tanks with fine lees which are gently stirred.

Tasting notes:

Deep crimson.

Fruits (tomatoes,...) and spices (balsamic,...).

Cherry kirsch, wild herbs, liquorice, exotic spices.

Medium bodied and voluptuous with a slight pearly effect which gives a light and airy side to the wine (airy is perhaps pushing it a bit), but in any case greedy!

Pairing:

Mixed grills, red and white meats...

Recommendations:

Serve at 13°C

Aging potential: At least 10 years.
