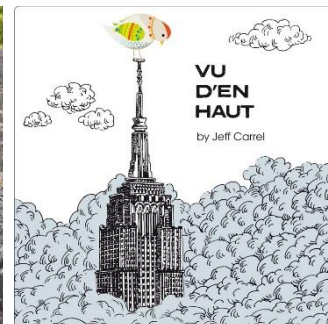


Jeff Carrel Vu d'en Haut

Appellation: VDF (Organic)

Vintage: 2021

Alcohol: 11,5%

Grape varieties: Malbec

Terroir: Vines over 10 years old / North West of Béziers / 3,8 ha plot of land / At the bottom of a siliceous clay slope.

Vines: On average 4400 vine roots per hectare.

Vinification methods: Mechanical harvesting at night / Directly pressed / Settling by nitrogen flotation without sulphites or other products / Indigenous yeasts / Malolactic fermentation 100% / Yield of 87 hl/ha.

Maturing: In stainless steel tanks on lees.

Tasting notes:

A nuance somewhere between the rose petal and the eye of a partridge.

Very discreet on the nose with notes of minerals and spices.

The taste is fine and long with an intense spicy aromas.

The end taste is accentuated by a slight bitterness and freshness, as a whole very harmonious.

Pairing:

Grilled meats, vegetables on the plancha and fresh summer salads...

Recommendations:

Serve between 14 and 16°C

Aging potential: 1 to 2 years
